1. Adam SIMMS, a Special Member of the Australian Federal Police, appeared before me and made application for an authority for a period to be specified for the purpose of sub paragraph 23CB(2) of the Crimes Act 1914 in the Mohamed HANEEF at pm on

2. I have previously authorised on two separate occasions for a specified period to be disregarded in calculating the investigation period pursuant to section 23CA(8)(m) and section 23CB(2) in relation to Mohamed HANEEF. The initial application was made for a specified period of 48 hours effective from 2320 hours 3 July 2007. The second application was made for a specified period of 96 hours, and was authorised and effective as at 1905 hours 5 July 2007.

3. I, **MAGISTRATE JAMES STAWLEY GORDON**, hereby grant authority for a specified period of **48** hours, commencing at the time this instrument is signed.

4. I am satisfied that the offence to which the specified period relates is a terrorism offences as defined under the *Criminal Code*, namely an offence contrary to section 102.7(1) suspecting of supporting a terrorist organisation.

5. I am satisfied that it is appropriate to grant the specified time having had regard to the submission/s made before me and that detention of the person during the specified period is necessary to:

4a. assist with and enable completion of the investigation into the terrorism offence for which the aforesaid person is detained;


4b. there is a continuing need to collate and analyse information being sourced from overseas authorities.

4c. to allow authorities in Australia to collect, collate and analyse material relevant to the investigation from a variety of sources.

4d. to enable collection of information relevant to the investigation from a place outside Australia that is in a time zone different from Australia.


