**RE: MOHAMED HANEEF**

We refer to our correspondence forwarded to you by our office on 3 September 2007 requesting documents that were referred to or used in the interrogation of our client. We note that we do not appear to have received a reply to that letter.

Since our client has a statutory right to the audio tapes and transcripts of the interrogations, it seems in the spirit of that legislation that he have access to copies of the documentation used in the questioning so that the questions and answers may be fully understood.

We note, in our previous correspondence to your office, we requested documents that belonged to our client or were created as a result of the interrogation of his property or personal information relating to him.

It was, previously, noted that the types of documents we are referring to include telephone records showing calls which were made; the timing of those calls; and the times when those calls were made. They also include passages from our client's diary and pages taken from our client's property, including those pages found in his diary. We also ask that the loose page in which the police officers had written on be forwarded to our office.

In our previous correspondence, we also noted that the documents include the transcripts of chatroom conversations and the translation of those conversations by police translators.

We make a further request that you forward to our office, in addition to those documents listed above, all and every document that came into your possession as a result of the electronic search of Dr Haneef's laptop computer.



I refer to your letter of 3 September 2007 and Mr Russo's letter of the same date.

In relation to Mr Russo's request for further information, the AFP has complied with its obligation to provide material to your client. I note that your firm has placed on the record that the AFP has complied with its obligations under part 1C of the *Crimes Act 1914* (Cth) and to this end your client has been given copies of all the audio records of interviews that he participated in as well as the associated transcripts.

All property belonging to your client that was seized has been returned, including that relied upon in the record of interview.

The AFP will not be providing any additional material as sought by Mr Russo, noting that the AFP has fully complied with its legal obligations in this regard.

In relation to your letter concerning our contact with the Queensland Legal Services Commission, that matter is being addressed by the Legal Services Commissioner and should the Legal Services Commission consider it necessary to contact you directly, undoubtedly it will do so. The AFP will not presuppose what action, if any, the Legal Services Commission may take in relation to the conduct of individuals acting for Dr Haneef.

Further to previous correspondence, we are instructed to request that you provide to us copies of documents that were used by your officers in asking our clients questions in the two interviews that were conducted with him.

As we understand the situation, the documents about which Dr. Haneef was questioned were documents which either belonged to him or were created as a result of interrogation of his property or personal information relating to him.

The types of documents we are referring to include telephone records showing calls which were made; the timing of those calls; and the times when those calls were made. They also include passages from our client's diary and pages taken from our client's property including pages found in his diary. We, particularly, seek the loose page on which police officers had written so that we can clear up an earlier misunderstanding.

The documents also include the transcripts of chat room conversations and the translation of those conversations by police translators.

We understand that we can duplicate the police processes in some respects and obtain our copies including from property that has been returned to our client. However, we want to make sure that we do not create errors or misunderstandings by purporting to refer to one document (or page of a diary) when, unbeknownst to us, the questions were asked about another document or page.

We would also seek to place on record our thanks for your provision of transcripts of the interviews in accordance with your obligations under part 1C of the Crimes Act. We would want to place on record that we have not intended to suggest that you were in breach of those obligations although we were puzzled by the amount of time that was taken in completing the second transcript which, on our understanding, was a matter of great priority for your organisation.

We would also note that the Minister for Immigration, Mr. Andrews, seems to be under a misapprehension that there are some matters about which our client has not been questioned
